### FAIRVALLEY CABERNET SAUVIGNON

- 2005 vintage** publication: *Wine Spectator* **84 points**  
 This wine shows classic Cabernet fruit, with cassis and dark berry flavours. The tannin is elegant and integrates well with the gentle oak influences.
- 2005 vintage** publication: *Wine Enthusiast- BEST BUY* **87 points**  
 This wine shows classic Cabernet fruit, with cassis and dark berry flavours. The tannin is elegant and integrates well with the gentle oak influences. (Wine makers comment)
- 2004 vintage** publication: *Wine Enthusiast* **85 points**  
 Medium-bodied with dry tannins yet a smooth, approachable feel, this wine has sweet black current and plum flavors wrapped in a light layer of leather that picks up intensity towards the finish. — M.D. (12/31/2006)

### FAIRVALLEY CHENIN

- 2007 vintage** publication: *Wine Spectator* **85 points**  
 ‘Show a mix of plump melon fruit followed by a tangy lemon zest on the finish.’
- 2005 vintage** publication: *Wine Enthusiast* **86 points**
- 2002 vintage** publication: *Wine Spectator* **86 points**  
 Elegant, with black cherry and tobacco notes, a hint of chocolate and supple texture carrying the finish. Faint earthy note adds interest. Drink now through 2004.

### FAIRVALLEY PINOTAGE

- 2004 vintage** publication: *Wine Enthusiast* **88 points**  
 The Fairvalley Workers Association was founded in 1997 by workers from the Fairview Wine & Cheese Estate with funds from Fairview’s owner Charles Back and the South African government. This young Pinotage (the first was in 2001) is a standout. Plush and inviting, modern and sexy, it has deep aromas of berry, plum and barnyard nuanced with lemon and spice. There are pure fruit flavors of plum and berry, and hints of leather and spice to add character. This wine shows what Pinotage can be. — M.D. (11/15/2006)
- 2003 vintage** publication: *Wine Spectator* **84 points**  
 Dark cocoa and plum flavors, with briary tannins and a tangy, minerally finish. Needs some hearty fare. Drink now. 5,000 cases imported. -JM
- 2002 vintage** publication: *Wine Spectator* **84 points**

Fresh, clean and ripe, with vanilla and chocolate notes covering cherry and black cherry fruit. Nice briary finish. Drink now. 3,300 cases made. -/M

FAIRVALLEY SAUVIGNON BLANC

Shows asparagus, garlic chive and citrus notes with a fresh, juicy finish. Drink now.
